### **Additional Transaction File Names**

## Transaction File Names

The Administrative Simplification provision of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA) requires health care organizations to provide standard transactions. EDI Services provides a conduit to route these transactions. Some payers may require providers to use another route for these transactions.

Below is a list of transactions you may find in your trading partner mailbox. Reports such as the TA1 Report, the 997 Report and the Claims Confirmation Report are not listed in this section and can be found under Response Reports for All Transactions.

The naming formats are listed below to help providers understand the types of files found in their mailbox. In the examples listed below, the EDI System will assign the sequence number.
