I. Kansas Choice –includes Plan A or Plan B

Kansas Choice is a Blue Choice product. Hospital services should be obtained at a Blue Choice hospital.

Non-hospital facility services should be obtained from a CAP provider. Non-hospital providers include home health agencies, hospice agencies, freestanding substance abuse facilities, end stage renal disease facilities and birthing centers.

New Directions is involved in the approval of Behavioral Health services for State of Kansas enrollees. This includes:

- Precertification of inpatient behavioral health admissions
- Prior authorization for Autism services
