132 new codes, 90 revised codes, and 70 deleted codes. Some of these are:

- E/M
- ESRD
- Cardiology
- Hydration, Injections, Infusion, and
Chemotherapy
- General Surgery

- Neonatal and pediatric critical/intensive care services, as well as newborn care, were re-numbered and new codes added

- 300 new codes, 55 revised codes, and 22 deleted codes
 - Infectious disease
 - Neoplasm
 - Post-transplant lymphoproliferative disorder (PTLD)
 - Secondary diabetes
 - Androgen insensitivity
 - Hungry bone syndrome
 - Graft versus host disease
 - Thrombocytopenia
 - Headache and migraine
